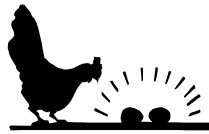

Why buy Mossback Farm Eggs?

Healthy: Our laying hens are fed all organic or locally sourced non-GMO feed, plus all the grass and bugs they can eat. They are antibiotic-free and are never fed any meat by-products.

Humane: Chickens love running around, pecking and scratching for fresh food, and making lots of noise, and our chickens get to do just that! Our hens aren't merely "cage-free" or given "access to the outdoors" - they actually live outside and have access to portable hen houses where they lay their eggs, take shelter from rain, and sleep at night.

Local: Most eggs sold in markets are grown out of state and shipped in... ours live in beautiful Yamhill county, only about an hour from your door.

Sustainable: The hens help us by fertilizing our pastures, lightly tilling the soil, reducing pest populations, and supplying fertilizer for our gardens. We move the hens frequently to new pasture so the growing grass can take in the nutrients and renew itself.

Taste: Many of our customers consistently tell us that our eggs are the best they have ever eaten! Our eggs have a richer flavor than supermarket eggs, and are wonderful for any culinary purpose.

Support your farmers: Our Egg Drop delivery program is a "CSA" which stands for Community Supported Agriculture. In a CSA, you, the customer, supports a local farmer by paying in advance for a "share" in our harvest. This helps us by providing working capital to help offset feed and other costs

Regular weekly delivery: Our eggs are only available on a regular basis through our CSA. We will be participating in some area farmers markets this year, but to be assured of a regular supply of our eggs, we recommend joining our CSA!

Good value: For \$4/ dozen or \$2.50/half dozen (or less if you sign up for multiple seasons!), you get eggs of wonderful quality from the happiest chickens in Yamhill county!

Common questions



Can I get just half a dozen eggs per week?

Yes! Due to popular demand, we will continue offering half shares at \$2.50/half dozen/week this year. Feel free to split a whole share with a neighbor, but please note that you will be responsible for dividing up the eggs or alternating pick-up weeks.

Can I get extra eggs?

Depending on our supply, we may be able to bring extra eggs for you periodically upon request. This is on a first come, first served basis, so if you want extra eggs contact us via phone or email and we'll let you know if we can help you out.

What is the date on the side of the carton?

The date is the day we cleaned and packed the eggs.

What if I forget to pick-up my eggs?

If you call us as soon as you realize, we can contact the site host to see if the eggs are still available for pick-up. In order to help folks remember their eggs, we send email reminders on Wednesdays.



New this year: organic fruit shares!

In our continuing effort to support other local farmers and to provide our customers with quality foods, we are teaming up with some local fruit growers this year to bring our customers 4 deliveries of wonderful organic fruit!

We'll deliver blueberries in June, cherries in July, peaches in August, and apples in September.

You can choose between a family sized share (approx. 30/ lbs of fruit for \$70) or a canning share (approx 50 lbs of fruit for \$120)

We'll let you know the exact delivery dates a week or two before they happen.

How does it work?

We...

...deliver eggs for you to a specified location in Portland, Forest Grove, or McMinnville

...email you a reminder the day before each pick-up

You...

...specify egg quantity and pick-up location

...send in the order form along with payment

...pick up the eggs between 3pm and 8pm on Thursdays

That's all you need to do to be assured of a fresh, local, weekly supply of eggs!

After we receive your order, we'll call or email to confirm your start date and to give you the pick-up address.

Some final details...

Since eggs are perishable and must be kept cold, eggs must be picked up on **Thursdays**. If you can't pick them up, please make arrangements for a friend or neighbor to pick them up for you. Or call us and we'll donate your eggs to a food bank.

We anticipate being able to meet your weekly order. In case of occasional shortages, we may cancel a delivery and extend the season. If we have a catastrophic loss of chickens (unlikely, but in farming, anything is possible), we promise to credit your payment, minus the eggs already received from us, toward eggs in the 2006 season.
